

INTRODUCTION

Unlike fine wines, Havana cigars do not suffer excessively from "good" and "bad" years. However, like fine wines, Havanas do improve with age. We are delighted to offer you The Boisdale Vintage Selection of aged cigars. These aged cigars are marked with an asterisk (*) and command a premium price.

All boxes of Havanas officially imported into the UK carry a colour-coded English Market Selection ("EMS") label which enables the connoisseur to determine the year in which duty was paid on the cigar. The vintages quoted in this list are derived from the EMS label and indicate the minimum age of the cigar, although not the year of harvest of the tobacco from which it is made.

Members of The Boisdale Jazz & Cigar Club receive a 25% discount on cigar prices except for The Boisdale Vintage Selection. 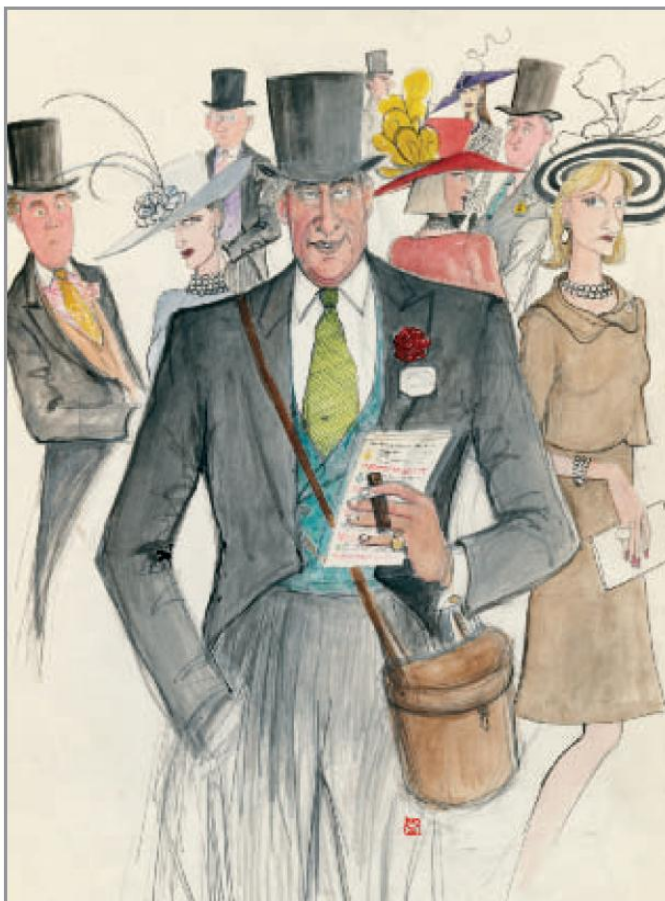
