Sassenachs & Royal Bank of Scotland staffers alike are welcome at this 'absolutely excellent' slice of bonnie Scotland in Bishopsgate, where the 'great home-made food' is 'as good as at the Victoria original'. The two-course menu is meaningfully priced at £17.45 (the year of Bonnie Prince Charlie's rebellion): expect to swallow Arbroath smokie fish-cakes & roast Macsween haggis along with the history lesson. A la carte options take in 'gorgeous' Scottish beef, game, salmon & shellfish; there's not a deep-fried Mars bar in sight. Service likewise wins praise, while the 'nicely tucked away' location is somewhere 'you could happily stay all afternoon', perhaps lingering on for 1930s/40s/50s jazz nights.
