Boisdale

Boisdale is a restaurant chain in London rooted in Scottish heritage. It is renowned for its tartan décor, Caledonian fare, vast whisky menu, infamous cigar terrace and eclectic programme of live entertainment. The original Belgravia outpost opened in 1986, followed by Bishopsgate, Canary Wharf and most recently, Mayfair. A night at Boisdale comes loaded with live music, food, drink and merriment, doused in Scottish flavour.



Jools Holland is Boisdale's Patron of Music and assists in curating an energetic schedule of nightly jazz music across all four outposts. There is also a weekly Sunday Jazz Club in Canary Wharf, playing easy-listening, soulful music all afternoon. Look out for special offers, such as unlimited prosecco with your meal on a Friday night for an additional £15.
