<b>Pommery Grand Cru 2004</b>		79.50
Pommery Grand Cru 2004 Vintage Champagne is made from 50% Chardonnay & 50% Pinot Noir, from a selection of seven Grand Crus & is aged for more than four years on its lees. The end result is a wine of surprising youth & freshness, with flavours of white flowers, honey & lemon zest, giving way to a hazelnut & brioche creaminess which is well worth savouring.		
<b>Dom Perignon 2006</b>	24.50	125.00
An elegant & distinguished style, the 2004 vintage is well-balanced & mature. The acidity, the fruit & aromas of brioche unite harmoniously on the palate, with hints of cashew nuts, fresh almonds & grapefruit. The body is fresh, ending on an intense finish, subtle, rich & very fine.

Ruinart Rosé was first released in 1962. It is the blanc de blanc to which 15% Pinot has been added. Sublime golden pink in colour, a subtle nose of cherry & freshly-picked red berries leads to a fleshy and delightfully smooth finish.



One of our all-time favourites, this has to be one of the most consistently excellent malt whiskies of the past 10 years. Showered with awards and praise from all quarters, it was named as 'Best Spirit in the World' by F Paul Pacult of the Spirit Journal in 2005. Unfailingly excellent, especially after a good meal.

**Macallan Reflexion** 147.40

Part of The Macallan's decanter series, Reflexion follows on from the success of M. Matured in first-fill sherry hogsheads – both American and Spanish oak – this shows excellent balance between citrus zest, sultana and spicy flavours.

**Glenrothes 1988** 53.35

This is a famous whisky aged for more than 20 years in a mix of Spanish and American oak. Spicy and fruity with notes of red apples, berry fruits, oak & vanilla.

**Glenfiddich Excellence 26yr** 63.70

Aged exclusively in ex-bourbon casks sourced from the Kelvin Cooperage in Kentucky. A twisting aroma with salted caramel, vanilla fudge, rich cocoa and subtle grassy notes to round out this superb expression.

**The Balvenie 25yr Single Barrel** 85.85

Notes of crushed almonds, Sicilian honey, coconut, vanilla and sweet black liquorice. Light up an Epicure No2, pour a dram, sit back and enjoy!

**Bowmore 15yr Darkest** 18.95

The Bowmore Darkest has flourished since it gained a 15 year-old age statement. The sweet sherry notes take precedence over the peat here.

**Maker's 46 Kentucky Bourbon** 15.05

The first new Maker's Mark recipe for at least 50 years, Maker's 46 is named for the number of different wood 'recipes' they tried before getting it right. Bottled at 47% it is matured in part in barrels containing a 'ladder' of toasted new French oak barrel staves to give more spice, sweetness and vanilla

**The Balvenie 14yr Caribbean Cask** 14.25

To create the ideal finish Malt Master David Stewart filled American oak casks with his own blend of select West Indian rums. The result is an exceptional single malt whisky with the traditional smooth, honeyed character of The Balvenie, married with notes of toffee and a hint of fruit, with a warm, lingering finish.

**Auchentoshan 18yr** 23.40

Rife with toasty oak and vanilla spice. Chocolate cake and a lovely grassiness. Toasty vanilla, dark nuttiness on the palate, with a malty finish, little custard and fresh flowers.

**Glenfiddich 18yr** 19.45

A truly exceptional single malt, with great consistency and character. Flavours of oak, baked apple and cinnamon are drawn from an intense marrying period, to produce a warming and distinguished finish.

**Laphroaig Lore** 21.40

Created by Distillery Manager John Campbell, Laphroaig Lore is said to be the richest ever Laphroaig! Named after the skills passed down over the generations, this permanent addition to the range is matured in a combination of casks including first fill Sherry butts and quarter casks and is said to contain some of their "most precious stock".


