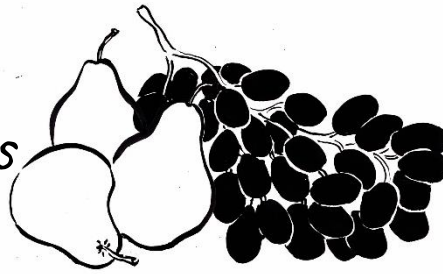


# Armagnac & Calvados

<b>Baron de Sigognac VSOP</b>	40%	£8.60
Top quality Armagnac from Bas Armagnac with six months in new oak and seven years in old oak casks.		
<b>Lecompte Pays d'Aux 5yr</b>	40%	£14.05
Characterized by the fruit. The fine and discreet presence of the wood has managed to combine with the lightness of the apple.		
<b>Lecompte Pays d'Aux 12yr</b>	40%	£20.25
With fruit always dominant, the Lecompte 12 year is more complex and more intense, it surprises in its aromatic maturity. Its beautiful notes of cinnamon and nutmeg combined with aromas of caramelized compote and roasted hazelnuts end on a final note of licorice.		
<b>Lecompte Pays d'Aux 25yr</b>	40%	£41.35
This cuvée combines smoky notes and aromas of candied fruits ranging from apple to prune, via rhubarb jam. Its varied scents are revealed throughout a slow and progressive tasting in the image of the patience of the Master of Chai.		
<b>Lecompte Pays d'Aux 1982</b>	40%	£47.45
This bond between Richard Prével and Vintage 1982 marks the history of his career as Master of Chai, raising this Calvados Pays d'Auge to the most emblematic vintage of the Maison Lecompte.		

## Liqueurs

<b>Amber from Macallan</b>	25%	£39.70
Macallan's short-lived Amber whisky based liqueur, which was discontinued some time back despite winning more than one award in its brief lifetime. Flavoured with pecan and maple syrup. Now very rare.		
<b>Baileys</b>	17%	£7.00
The biggest selling liqueur in the world and the first to bottle cream and spirit without it splitting.		
<b>Benedictine</b>	40%	£9.80
You can expect plenty of honey and herbs from this monastic liqueur.		
<b>Bitter Truth Pimento Dram</b>	22%	£11.45
Pimento dram is based on allspice (aka pimento or Jamaican pepper) and also includes the likes of cloves, nutmeg and cinnamon. A highly sought-after cocktail ingredient of yore.		
<b>Bitter Truth Violet</b>	22%	£11.95
A fabulously intense creme de violette from Bitter Truth. As you would expect from this exalted producer, only the finest ingredients are used - in this case wild alpine violet flowers. This will revolutionise your Aviations.		
<b>Chambord</b>	16.5%	£9.20
A five-star liqueur, made with 'black raspberries' and other bramble fruits, infused in aged cognac. Perfect for dressing up desserts or sweetening a cocktail. And anyone who can enlighten me as to how the French 'black raspberry' differs from the British 'blackberry' will earn extra bonus points.		

<b>Chartreuse Green</b>	55%	<b>£14.25</b>
The Chartreuse most of us recognise from Granny's drinks cabinet. Not to everyone's taste, but for those brave enough to approach with an open mind, this is a remarkable and delicious liqueur.		
<b>Cherry Heering</b>	23.5%	<b>£8.15</b>
This classic Danish cherry liqueur is complex and has a full three years of aging.		
<b>Cointreau</b>	40%	<b>£7.55</b>
A classic orange liqueur with a big hit of tangerine on the nose.		
<b>Disaronno Amaretto</b>	24%	<b>£7.25</b>
The classic almond after dinner tippie.		
<b>Drambuie</b>	40%	<b>£9.60</b>
A secret recipe of herbs, spices & heather honey crafted with aged scotch whiskies, remained unchanged since 1745.		
<b>Frangelico</b>	20%	<b>£7.15</b>
Named after Italian hermit monk Father Angelico, the recipe for this hazelnut liqueur dates back over 300 years.		
<b>Galliano</b>	30%	<b>£6.70</b>
Formulated in Italy from 25 ingredients including vanilla and star anise.		
<b>Grand Marnier</b>	46%	<b>£9.40</b>
Made with Cognac and Seville oranges, this makes a sophisticated after dinner digestif.		
<b>Grappa Nardini Bianco</b>	50%	<b>£9.30</b>
Nardini's Grappa Bianca is one of Italy's best selling premium grappas. Excellently balanced, this is a delightfully complex yet elegant grappa with notes of jasmine tea and gingerbread.		
<b>Italicus Rosolio di Bergamotto</b>	20%	<b>£11.40</b>
Italicus Rosolio di Bergamotto is a blend of bergamot peel, Cedro lemons, chamomile, lavender, gentian, yellow roses and Melissa balm. An aromatic and lightly spicy liqueur which balances honeyed sweetness with rooty bitterness.		
<b>Kahlua</b>	20%	<b>£7.00</b>
Quality rum-based coffee liqueur.		
<b>King's Ginger</b>	41%	<b>£9.00</b>
This unique liqueur became famous in the reign of King Edward VII when, at the request of the King's doctor, it was produced as a warming drink for His Majesty to take after winter morning rides. The distinctive smooth ginger flavour is perfectly balanced by a pleasingly clean, dry finish.		
<b>Kirsch Vieux (Cherry) Grande Reserve Eau De Vie</b>	43%	<b>£11.60</b>
A cherry eau-de-vie from Miclo, made using a base of cherry and chosen from their finest maturing spirit. Miclo's Grande Réserve range are aged for three to four years before bottling (rather than the two years for the Tradition range).		
<b>Kummel Wolfschmidt</b>	39%	<b>£9.80</b>
Famous aniseed-and-caraway-flavoured liqueur with a great mouth coating texture and a honeyed finish, Kummel is best served chilled to within an inch of its life.		

**Legendre Herbsaint** 50% **£12.80**

Legendre Herbsaint is an anise flavoured spirit. Created by two gentlemen from New Orleans, who learnt about absinthe making in France in the First World War (of which herbsaint is almost an anagram). This was intended to be an absinthe substitute after it was banned.

**Licor 43** 31% **£7.90**

This Spanish liqueurs ingredients include citrus and other fruit juices, vanilla and aromatic herbs and spices, there are 43 of them in total, giving the liqueur its name.

**Limonbello** 30% **£8.75**

Inspired by a family recipe, Limonbello takes the familiar and gives it a bold, modern makeover. Gone is the bitter edge and refined sugar, replaced with organic ingredients that provide the most delightful sugar-free taste experience.

**Luxardo Maraschino** 32% **£12.90**

An authentic maraschino made to a recipe dating from 1821 using the Marasca cherry. Aged for two years in Finnish oak vats prior to bottling, this pretty much sets the standard.

**Luxardo Sambuca** 40% **£7.00**

Made by macerating aniseed & elderberries in neutral spirit before maturation in oak vats. Serve 'alla mosca' - flamed with three floating coffee beans in the glass.

**Mandarine Napoleon** 38% **£11.55**

A high-quality Belgian liqueur made with tangerines, Cognac and a secret recipe of botanicals. Said to have been a favourite of the Emperor himself.

**Merlet Lune d'Abricot (Apricot Brandy)** 25% **£8.75**

Merlet Lune d'Abricot is a traditional French Apricot Brandy. Apricots grown in Roussillon are macerated in pure alcohol then blended with extracts of apricot kernels and Merlet's own 2 to 6 year old Cognacs. Finally sugar is added.

**Mozart Black Chocolate** 17% **£8.35**

A carefully produced dark chocolate liqueur from the Austrian chocolate fiends at Mozart. A combination of cocoa and vanilla, with some of the cocoa spirit aged to enhance the flavour.

**Pama Pomegranate** 17% **£12.00**

Flavoured with pomegranate and coloured with elderberry and grapeskin extract, Pama is a rather modern French liqueur, recommended in Martinis and Margaritas.

**Pernod Absinthe** 68% **£12.60**

Pernod Absinthe was the biggest selling absinthe of the 19th century.

**Peychaud's Aperitivo** 11% **£6.25**

An aperitivo from Peychauds, makers of world-famous New Orleans Creole bitters! Great in refreshing summer drinks, for example mix with sparkling wine for tasty spritz.

**Solerno Blood Orange** 40% **£15.50**

Solerno Blood Orange Liqueur is made in Scotland and is produced by Leslie Gracie, the creator of Hendrick's Gin. Made by marrying the fresh essential oil of blood oranges with Italian lemon and neutral spirit before being lightly sweetened with natural sugar.

**Southern Comfort** 35% **£7.50**

Southern Comfort is made with American grain spirit and peaches and tastes great with traditional lemonade, or with vodka, orange & grenadine: the 'Alabama Slammer'.

**Southern Comfort 100 Proof** 50% **£18.50**

Higher-strength, deluxe version of Southern Comfort, this smooth liqueur is great for giving a bit of extra bite to any of the myriad cocktails that use it.

**St. Germain Elderflower** 20% **£8.75**

Made entirely from fresh, handpicked elderflowers, this is subtle yet complex.

**Strega** 40% **£10.20**

Invented in Italy in 1860, Strega is a classic herb-based liqueur that achieves its bright yellow colour not from nasty e-numbers but through the addition of saffron - one of around 70 herbs in the recipe.

**Suze** 20% **£6.00**

A spicy, fruity aperitif made in the Thuir region of southern France since 1889. Made using wild yellow gentian from Auvergne, this is a secret ingredient of many bartenders. Try it over ice, with tonic or add a splash to your martini.

**Tia Maria** 20% **£7.00**

A classic coffee liqueur, Tia Maria is a cunning combination of cane spirit, coffee, vanilla and sugar and has enjoyed worldwide success since its invention in Jamaica in the 1940s.

**Velvet Falernum** 11% **£5.40**

The sweet alcoholic cordial that's the key to making Caribbean drinks, Taylor's Velvet Falernum is a mix of citrus and spice which is also excellent on its own over ice.



## PISCO

**Macchu Pisco** ABV Per 50 ml

Macchu Pisco is a Peruvian pisco made from Quebranta grapes and then rested for one year to allow the spirit to mellow and reveal its true character.

La Diablada is a blended (or acholado) pisco made from Italia, Moscatel, Quebranta and Torontel grapes. Each of these is distilled separately and then rested for two years.

## Cognac

A blend of nine Caribbean pot stillled rums. Mind blowing, with that signature Pyrat orange tang.

**Ron Mulata 15 Year Old Gran Reserva Añejo** 38% **£20.60**

It has been aged in 180 litre oak casks, which the distillers say give it the distinctively light and subtle flavour profile. The 15 year old is perfect for tasting neat, for savouring the classic aged rums notes, for enjoying enjoying with a fine cigar. Simply superb.

**Sailor Jerry Spiced Rum, Caribbean** 40% **£7.25**

A blend of rum, vanilla, lime and spices. The brand was names after Norman Collins, an American tattoo artist who was famed for his sailor tattoos and was given the nickname 'Sailor Jerry'.

**Wray & Nephew Overproof, Jamaica** 63% **£10.05**

The nose is fruity. Notes of molasses and spice. The palate is fruity and a little spiry. There are notes of banana and Demerara as well as spice and a little oak. The finish is long and spiced.

## Vermouth & Aromatic's

### Amer Picon

An Amer from French producers Picon. Amer is French aperitif which is usually flavoured with Bitter Orange and Gentian Root. Usually drunk at the beginning of a meal to help stimulate the appetite.

**Antica Formula Carpano** 16.5% **£6.90**

From Carpano, home of the first ever vermouth, this highly sought-after red vermouth is made to an original recipe dating from 1786. Your Manhattans will never be the same again.

**Aperol** 11% **£6.00**

Italian amari, a lovely summery drink made from rhubarb and gentian. Great in a spritz.

**Campari** 25% **£6.00**

Wonderful with grapefruit juice or in a classic Negroni cocktail, Campari is flavoured with a bewildering array of 68 herbs and spices.

**Cocchi Americano** 16.5% **£6.70**

It's acclaimed as the most credible alternative to the long-discontinued Kina Lillet due to its high levels of cinchona, the fiercely bitter bark used to make quinine. This makes Cocchi Americano essential in recreating James Bond's Vesper Martini and the Corpse Reviver #2 from The Savoy Cocktail Book.

**Dolin Vermouth de Chambéry** 16% **£6.00**

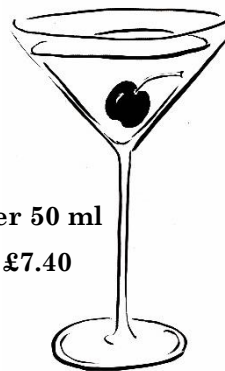
The original French vermouth. Dry and austere with light body.

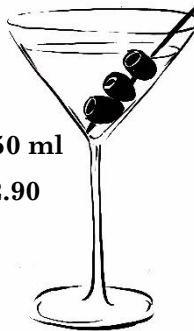

<b>Belvedere Pure</b>	40%	<b>£7.95</b>
Belvedere is unique thanks to its locally sourced ingredients: Dankowskie gold rye and pristine artesian water from Belvederes own wells. The rye creates character and the water brings smoothness.		
<b>Belvedere Single Estate Rye Vodka - Lake Bartezek</b>	40%	<b>£14.50</b>
In late 2017, Belvedere kicked off their Single Estate Rye Vodka range, showcasing the terroir of the Polish rye that makes their high-quality expressions. This particular bottling was made with rye grown on a single estate on the shores of Lake Bartezek.		
<b>Belvedere Single Estate Rye Vodka - Smogóry Forest</b>	40%	<b>£14.50</b>
One of two vodkas released by Belvedere released part of their Single Estate Rye range in late 2017. This particular edition was crafted using rye grown on a single estate in Smogóry, a village in Poland surrounded by forests. The range aims to show off the terroir and quality of the rye grain which goes to making Belvedere's spirits.		
<b>Golovkine</b>	40%	<b>£11.00</b>
Count Gavriil Ivanovich Golovkine was Royal Chancellor to Tsar Peter the Great and his Ambassador to the Court of Louis XIV in the early 18th century. He is also reputed to have been responsible for organising some of the Russian court's more exotic and scandalous entertainments. The vodka named in his honour is a distillation of his aristocratic and sophisticated spirit with undertones of a richer, wilder character.		
<b>Reyka</b>	40%	<b>£8.95</b>
A small batch vodka produced in Iceland using a process that includes the filtration through lava rock. Made in one of only six carter head stills in the world.		
<b>Stolichnya Citros</b>	40%	<b>£8.45</b>
Made with a variety of citrus fruit majoring on lemons and limes, Stolichnaya Citros is a deliciously crisp vodka that goes very well with lemonade or tonic.		



**Stolichnya Elit** 40% **£14.45**

The zenith of Stoli's distillation technique, using a patented 'freeze-filtration' technique to produce an awesome vodka of unparalleled purity. Pure class.

**Stolichnya Vanilla** 40% **£8.45**

Infused with Madagascan vanilla for a fresh creamy flavour, Stolichnaya Vanilla is wonderful in a Martini with Stoli Razberi - or just drizzle it on ice-cream: sensational.

**Wyborowa** 40% **£7.00**

The popular Polish vodka is made from rye and is twice distilled in pot stills.

**Wyborowa Exquisite** 40% **£12.65**

Made using high quality grain grown near the village of Turew. Crisp and clean.

**Zubrowka** 40% **£7.00**

Percolated through a long grass this vodka has remarkable coconut notes. Have with apple juice and a squeeze of lemon, or else in one of our Applegrass cocktails.



**Arbikie Kirty's Gin**

Kirsty's Gin is made at Scotland's first farm-to-bottle distillery, Arbikie. Using the estate's potato vodka as a base, the botanicals include juniper, kelp, carline thistle and blaeberrys. A very Scottish gin that makes a delicious G&T.

**Beefeater 24** 45% **£8.45**

The first gin to be designed by Beefeater's master distiller Desmond Payne, 24 contains Sencha Green Tea and undergoes a slow distillation (hence the name).

**Beefeater Burrough's Reserve Oak Rested** 43% **£17.50**

Beefeater's Burrough's Reserve Gin is made to founder James Burrough's original 1860 recipe. Distilled by hand using his original 'Still number 12' with a 268 litre capacity, it is then rested in French oak barrels which used to contain Lillet - the first gin ever to do so.

**Bols Genever** 42% **£8.45**

Genever is the Dutch precursor to London Dry gin. This one is malty and delicious. Great on the side of a beer or in one of our Fosbury Flips.

**The Botanist Islay Dry Gin** 46% **£11.50**

An exciting and unusual gin from Islay whisky distillery Bruichladdich, The Botanist is made in a Lomond still christened Ugly Betty and contains no fewer than 31 botanicals, of which 22 are native to the Southern Hebridean island itself. These latter include the likes of mugwort, meadowsweet and the enigmatic Lady's Bedstraw flowers, and the resultant dry gin is described, perhaps unsurprisingly, as 'floral'.

**Daffy's Gin** 43.4% **£11.10**

Small batch, copper pot-distilled gin from Scotland, with a hint of Lebanese mint and eight other botanicals.

Hepple Gin uses an innovative three-level process for extracting botanical flavours. The heavier ones are distilled with the grain, lighter examples are vacuum distilled, and juniper flavour is extracted using carbon dioxide. Vibrant, intense and full of citrus and juniper flavour.		
<b>House of Elrick</b>	42%	<b>£13.10</b>
House of Elrick Gin comes to us from Aberdeen, featuring a selection of botanicals including juniper, coriander, citrus, angelica, pink peppercorn, sweet fennel, heather and rose petals. Not only that, it's made with fresh water drawn from Loch Ness!		
<b>Kew Organic Gin</b>	46%	<b>£8.75</b>
An organic gin that's the result of a partnership between The Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew, and the makers of the rather tasty Dodd's Gin (The London Distillery Company). Foraged seasonal flora from the world famous and internationally important Kew Gardens and other organic botanicals from around the world are distilled in Christina, a 140 litre copper pot still at Dodd's Gin's Battersea home. Truly a 'London' gin, that's for sure!		
<b>Kew Organic Gin Explorers Strength</b>	57.3%	<b>£11.35</b>
The cask-strength release of Dodd's organic gin. A collaboration between the London Distillery Company and Kew Royal Botanical Gardens. A blend of 15 botanicals including cubeb pepper, nutmeg, cinnamon, this is spicy with lots of citrus flavour. This makes a characterful G&T.		
<b>Le Gin de Christian Drouin</b>	42%	<b>£11.65</b>
This is the only Gin incorporating 30 varieties of apple. Flavours of rose and lemon provide delicacy, while ginger, vanilla, cinnamon and almond notes give the Gin a smooth, spicy body. Cardamom enhances its fruit and roundness in the mouth and juniper and apple complement one another with their heavy and high notes - spicy and crisp.		
<b>Nicholson Gin</b>	40.3%	<b>£12.70</b>
Originally created in 1736, Nicholsons Gin has made a comeback. Created to a recipe that's close to the original by descendants of the original founders, the botanicals include citrus peels, liquorice, cinnamon, nutmeg, cassia and more. Citrus-led, spicy and balanced, this works well with tonic.		
<b>No. 3 London Dry Gin</b>	46%	<b>£7.95</b>
No. 3 London Dry is distilled in copper pot stills at De Kuyper in the Netherlands, counts cardamom seeds and grapefruit peel among its botanicals, and has been bottled at an invigorating 46%.		
<b>Plymouth Gin</b>	41.2%	<b>£10.10</b>
An elegant redesign of Plymouth, matching up their much respected and geographically protected gin with an old-school chunky bottle and their traditional branding. A must have for any home cocktail bar or lovers of a gin and tonic.		

<b>Plymouth Sloe Gin</b>	26%	<b>£9.35</b>
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Plymouth Sloe Gin liqueur is made by gently steeping the finest sloes in Plymouth Gin and soft pure Dartmouth water.

<b>Plymouth Navy Strength Gin</b>	57%	<b>£10.50</b>
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The punchy naval strength version of Plymouth's long running and very tasty gin. Bottled at 57% for a more concentrated flavour that cuts through tonic and cocktails.

<b>Roku Gin</b>	57%	<b>£10.50</b>
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The first gin from Japan's legendary Suntory - Roku Gin. This expression is made using a selection of botanicals, including six Japanese botanicals provide a whistle-stop tour of the four seasons. These include sakura leaf and sakura flower for spring, sencha tea and gyokuro tea for summer, sansho pepper for autumn and yuzu peel for winter. Traditional gin botanicals also featured include the likes of juniper, orange peel, lemon peel, coriander and cinnamon, among others.

<b>Casamigos Silver Tequila</b>	40%	<b>£20.20</b>
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The process is slow, with the agave roasted for 10 times the average and fermented for twice as long. The silver is rested for two months after distillation and is an excellent example of the category.

<b>Fortaleza Blanco Tequila</b>	40%	<b>£16.50</b>
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Fortaleza Blanco is made by the fifth generation of the Sauza family. Made using traditional methods, this is exceptional with notes of black pepper, earth and butter.

<b>Gran Centenario Plata Tequila</b>	40%	<b>£19.80</b>
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Owned by Jose Cuervo, this is an exceptional-quality 100% agave silver tequila with a deliciously subtle palate and a long, smooth finish. A great value white tequila.

<b>Gran Centenario Reposado Tequila</b>	38%	<b>£11.05</b>
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A classic reposado aged around six months in white oak barrels. This is exactly how reposado should be, with a smooth body and balanced, pure agave flavours.

<b>Gran Centenario Anejo Tequila</b>	38%	<b>£11.80</b>
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An absolutely top-quality anejo from Gran Centenario that can be enjoyed on its own over ice, as a really smooth shot or in a bling Margarita. A tequila to savour.
